## Emmaus Homes, Summer Mission Camp

### ITEMS to BRING

CLOTHING: appropriate for weather conditions, casual clothing for work outdoors, work with Residents in their programs, and your group outings. DRESS Code: shorts need to be mid length or longer (no short shorts), shirts and blouses need to adequately cover your torso-chest and lower back, and shoes need to fully cover your feet for outdoor work assignments.

BEDDING: bring your own sleeping bag OR twin size sheet, cover and pillow.

HYGIENE: tooth brush and paste, shampoo, soap, towel, hairdryer, and other personal care items.

FOOD: group brings all food for your meals and snacks here. You will have use of the large Kitchen and dining Room on Campus for your meals. The Dormitory has a small kitchenette for snacks.

DAILY ROUTINE \_\_\_ You will have a staff Coordinator for the Mission Camps who will help you to individualize your schedule. All Campers work ½ day with Resident's in their Programs and ½ day with Physical labor projects appropriate for your age and skills. Evenings will be up to your group to design. You may create programs for Residents (visit in their home, or lead a karaoke party, make homemade ice cream, etc.). You may hike the trails here, visit our pond and paddle the row boat, play soccer or baseball, etc.

Some camp groups go into Washington, Mo. to swim at the YMCA pool.

Some groups leave for a day, mid-week, to explore sites of interest in the metro St. Louis, Mo. area.
