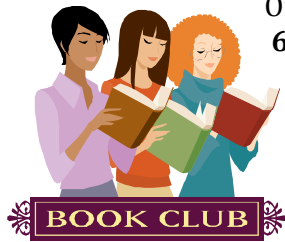
### Crafter's Corner

### Book Club

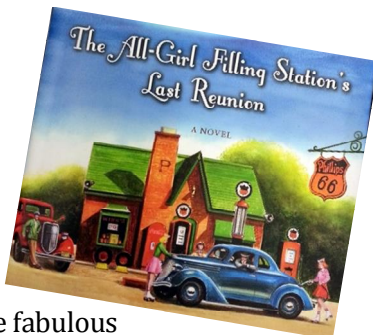
